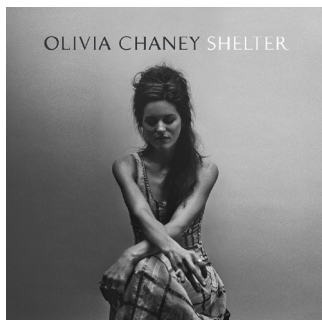
SHELTER Her second solo album – out June 15 - focuses on new self-composed material by this London-based singer/songwriter, matching the warm purity of her vocals with gracefully-crafted arrangements featuring acoustic and electric guitar, violin, piano, and an array of keyboard sounds from mellotron and organ to Rhodes and harmonium.

- ♦ Another 2017 collaboration on Nonesuch was with [Natalie Merchant](#), [Rhiannon Giddens](#), [Sam Amidon](#), and [Kronos Quartet](#) in folk song arrangements, dubbed “magnificent” by UK’s *Songlines*, “Chaney delivers with deathless beauty.”

- ♦ Her 2015 Nonesuch debut “The Longest River” which *The Guardian* hailed as ‘an enchanting and stately creation’, was noted in a number of [Best Of the Year](#) lists - [Uncut](#), [Mojo](#), [PopMatters](#), [Chicago Reader](#) and more - while the [Los Angeles Times](#) called it “an album which flows with distinctive beauty.”
- ♦ 2018 Touring: (le) Poisson Rouge NYC June 10th; U.S. show dates will run late July into August, with second leg in October, plus shows in the UK and Europe in summer and fall.

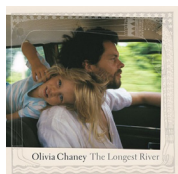
